## Read Ephesians 3:20-21

• Here Paul puts the church and Christ together "throughout all generations, forever and ever." Why do you think people have been separating the two of late? (e.g. "I love Jesus but not the Church.")

- Review the following "God Works" passages:
  - "On the seventh day God had completed his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done." (Genesis 2:2 CSB)
  - "The Rock—his work is perfect; all his ways are just. A faithful God, without bias, he is righteous and true." (Deuteronomy 32:4 CSB)
  - "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the expanse proclaims the work of his hands." (Psalm 19:1 CSB)
  - "Jesus replied, "This is the work of God—that you believe in the one he has sent."" (John 6:29 CSB)
  - "For it is God who is working in you both to will and to work according to his good purpose." (Philippians 2:13 CSB)
  - "They sang the song of God's servant Moses and the song of the Lamb:
  - Great and awe-inspiring are your works, Lord God, the Almighty; just and true are your ways, King of the nations." (Revelation 15:3 CSB)
- What new insights on "God Works" are you gaining?
